

Required Canoe Gear in Dry Bag

- Dry bag (40L – 60L)
- Sleeping Bag (summer-weight, synthetic)
- Sleeping Pad
- Sleeping Clothes – pack in sleeping bag.
- Rain Gear – Jacket & Pants [#]
- Compass & Pocket knife
- Personal First-aid kit
- Matches / lighter
- Flashlight/Headlamp & [fresh batteries]
- **Plate/Bowl/Cup/Spoon/Fork – personal eating**
- 2 water bottles
- Personal emergency gear [whistle, mirror, fire-starters, duct tape, water purification and garbage bag]
- Eyeglasses [w/croakies] & Spare eyeglasses (*if necessary*)
- Sunscreen [in plastic Ziploc bag]
- Insect repellent [in plastic Ziploc bag]
- Lip balm (with spf 25)
- Toilet paper [one roll]
- Hand sanitizer
- Toothpaste & tooth brush
- extra swim trunks or quick-drying short pants
- 1-2 shirts (wicking or quick drying)
- 1-2 pair socks
- 1-2 pair underwear
- Fleece or other lightweight cover-up
- Hat
- ½ of tent/ground-pad. [@]

Optional Canoe Gear in Dry Bag

- Plastic bag liner [*recommended*]
- Sunglasses w/Croakies [*recommended*]
- Bandannas/neckerchiefs
- Watch
- Towel
- Compact pillow
- Camp shoes
- Fingerless gloves
- Head-net
- Camera & case
- Compact binoculars
- Collapsible fishing gear
- Playing Cards
- Paper and pen/pencil
- Foam kneeling pad for canoe
- Camp chair or Stool

Personal Medications:

Medications are to be in a clearly marked plastic Ziploc bag with the proper form for each - given to Mr. Williams - before we depart.

Personal Gear in Duffel Bag

- Small backpack or duffel
- Rain Jacket [#]
- Underwear and Socks
- Sleep-ware [at least an extra shirt]
- Spare Scout Brown T-shirt [if you have one]
- Towel
- Toiletries and Shower stuff – one shower
- Small flashlight or headlamp
- Pillow/blanket [%]
- **Class B uniform** [+]
- **Class C uniform:** [Brown T-shirt, socks, belt, pants] & Summer Shoes [^].
- **Service Projects:** extra scouting t-shirts [2].
- **CANOE CLOTHES:** water shoes [*], swim suit or water shorts, quick dry shirt, sunglasses [pack in a small bag or in a plastic grocery bag that is tied closed to keep separate until ELY, MN].
- Coat Hanger for Uniform Shirt.

Crew Gear

- Dining fly and rope/line.
- 2 or 3 types of water purification systems (filter, Steri-Pen, chlorine/iodine tablets, or Aqua Mira)
- Collapsible water bladders. [5 gal.]
- Bear bag, Carbineer and [2] 50' ropes.
- Plastic trowel.
- Several large plastic trash bags [10]
- Several gallon Ziploc bags [10]
- Wilderness Outfitters will provide Colman dual burner stoves, fuel, cooking pots, utensils and a small saw.

Definitions and Notes:

[@] - Tent: 2-man, 3-season Free-standing backpacking style, with ground-pad. If you do not own one – use one of the Troops'. Large Family Type will not be acceptable.

[*] - Water-shoes: with durable sole, closed toe and heel coverage. Could be an old pair of quick-drying sneakers. Keens are acceptable – Crocs are not.

[#] - can be the same one.

[^] - Summer Shoes could be Sneakers, Keene's', or Boat Shoes – Something supportive with Closed toes and heel cover. No Crocs or Flip-Flops.

[%] - Can be brought on the night we leave.

[+] – ***Arrive in your Class B Uniform – Complete*** – this trip will use Summer Shoes [see above] & a ***waterproof watch to be worn the entire trip.***
